A rare Meissen teabowl and saucer, circa 1730, of quatrelobed shape, enamelled in Kakiemon style with scattered flowerheads and leaves, overglaze blue painted crossed swords mark to bases, length of saucer 11.5cm (minor faults).

### Condition Report

1258. Cup - light surface wear with a couple of nibbles to the footrim, largely insignificant.

Saucer - chips to rim located on each lobe, few smaller nibbles elsewhere on the rim. Some wear to enamel decoration in places, otherwise ok.
