A Royal Crown Derby Imari jar and cover, circa 1930, pattern number 6299, height 13cm, together with a pair of Royal Crown Derby Imari hexagonal jars and covers and a pair of early 19th century ironstone octagonal vases and covers, probably Mason's, decorated in the Imari palette, height 34cm (some faults).

Estimate: £100 - £150

Condition Report

1535. Urn 1 - both urn and cover in generally good order, small chip to rim of cover but otherwise no significant damage or repairs. Typical wear to gilt particularly on rims and edges and some typical light wear to enamels, bit dusty and dirty and would benefit from a clean. Finial to cover in good order.

Urn 2 - the urn itself is in similar order to the other one with typical wear to gilt and enamels. Small 2cm hairline to rim.

Unfortunately, the cover is in poor condition, broken into approx 6 pieces and re-glued with some losses and filler along breaks and sections of the inner rim missing. Finial detached and re-glued.
