A diamond and cultured pearl brooch, circa 1920, designed as an arrow, the feathers and point mounted with cushion cut diamonds, a single light pink tinted cultured pearl mounted to the terminal, width 6.3cm, cased.

Condition Report

502. The diamonds look to be attractive white stones, with one or two inclusions. The cultured pearl is in good condition. Possible evidence of use of lead solder when viewed from the back, beneath the arrow head and the front of the feathers. Hinge pin in good condition.
