A diamond set dress clip, circa 1920, mounted with cushion cut and rose cut diamonds, unmarked, width 2.1cm, length 3.1cm, with a case.

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## Condition Report

505. Principal diamond weight approx. 0.50-0.60ct. Total carat weight, very approx. 4.00ct. Colour on average approx. I-J. Clarity on average approx. SI. The setting is 18ct white gold but unmarked. The principal diamond slightly draws colour and shows some evidence of fluorescence. No significant inclusions. The remaining diamonds are a variety of old cut and cushion cut diamonds and look to be fairly clear stones generally. However, some diamonds slightly draw colour and show a degree of fluorescence. Hinge in good condition.

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
