### LOT 510

A Victorian diamond brooch, designed as a starburst, mounted with cushion and rose cut diamonds, the principal diamond mounted to the centre, unmarked, width 4.1cm, with a case.

Estimate: £1,000 - £1,500

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### Condition Report

510. Principal diamond weight approx. 0.50ct. Total carat weight approx. 3.00ct. Colour on average approx. I. Clarity on average approx. SI1-SI2. The mount is silver and gold, which has been later plated over. The diamonds slightly draw colour and look to be fairly clear stones. Note there is a mixture of cuts to the diamonds. One or two surface reaching inclusions but not many. There is a hook fitting at the back which originally would have supported a diamond set suspension loop for wear as a pendant, which is not lacking. The folding security catch to the hook of the clasp is of a later date. Suggested age 1880s/90s.

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
