### LOT 515

A late Victorian gold backed and silver set diamond brooch, designed as a crescent, mounted with three rows of graduated cushion and rose cut diamonds, unmarked, weight 6.9g, width 3.1cm.

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### Condition Report

515. Total carat weight, very approx. 3.00-4.00ct. Colour on average approx. H. Clarity on average approx. VS2-SI1. One of the larger diamonds has a gletz inclusion. The pin and hook fitting look to be original. The pin is a bit wobbly. The original screw down fitting which would have been at the back is missing. When viewed from the top the end points of the crescent are out of alignment.

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
