A gold oval link charm bracelet with a folding clasp, unmarked, fitted with sixteen pendants and charms, including a coffee pot shaped seal, a teapot, detailed '9c', a heart shaped pendant locket and an aeroplane, length 19cm, together with a gold and enamelled charm, detailed 'Windsor', designed as a view of Windsor Castle from the river, unmarked, total weight 34.8g.

Condition Report

539. Four leaf clover and violin are marked ♦9ct♦.

Dice holder has full 9ct gold hallmark.

Standing figure of bear, unmarked. Small heart, dented both sides and marked ♦9ct♦.

End of propelling pencil, unmarked.

Yale key, marked ♦9ct♦.

Heart shaped pendant locket, unmarked, likely to be gold back and front.

Aeroplane, marked ♦9ct♦.

Hollow duck, unmarked.

Coffee pot, unmarked. The top of the handle is a little worn.

Teapot marked ♦9c♦.

Cross, marked ♦9ct♦.

Swiss edelweiss flower, a little worn to the centre, unmarked.

St Christopher, rather worn and the blue enamelled border is worn.

Cornelian seal, unmarked, probably heavily gold cased but loaded interior, suspension loop is a little worn, but the cornelian itself is in good condition.

The connecting links of the charm bracelet are starting to show signs of wear.

Windsor charm ♦ is rather chipped around the edge, particularly to the sides and bottom section. The suspension loop is a little worn.
