A 9ct gold, amethyst and colourless gem set ring, mounted with three oval cut amethysts and two rows of three colourless gem set divisions, weight 6.5g, ring size approx P, and a pink sapphire and pink gem set full eternity ring, ring size approx N1/2.

Condition Report

581. Amethyst and colourless gem ring ♦ the principal amethyst has a large chip. The two side amethysts have some surface scuffs. The colourless gem set divisions have one or two tiny surface marks. The ring mount is in good condition. 9ct gold hallmark is illegible, only the ♦75♦ of ♦375♦ is apparent. Suggested age ♦ reproduction of a Victorian design, perhaps made in the 1960s.

Pink sapphire and pink gem set eternity ring ♦ some of the gemstones have surface reaching inclusions and some have small chips. Some variation of colour to the gemstones. When viewed from the side the mount appears to have an interior yellow gold band and a silver coloured metal outer band, which has engraved decoration. The ring is of a fairly basic construction but there are no signs to suggest that the stones are not original to the ring. Suggested age -1940s.

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
