A gold backed, silver set, diamond and cultured pearl pendant necklace in an interlooped tied ribbon bow design, claw set with four principal circular cut diamonds, further set with smaller circular cut diamonds and four cultured pearls at intervals, the front with a pendant drop terminating with a claw set circular cut diamond, unmarked, length 5.7cm, with a gold neckchain, detailed '750', on a boltring clasp, total weight 11.4g, with a case (the drop currently detached).

Condition Report

725. The diamonds are drawing colour. They look to be fairly clean stones internally. One of the pearls has been re-glued into position, the glue has flooded over and is on the surface of the metal in this area. The piece would benefit from a professional clean. The chain is a modern replacement. Suggested age of pendant ♦ Victorian style but later manufacture, note modern circular cut diamonds.

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
