A Victorian silver set and diamond bangle, the front with a lyre motif and three stars, mounted with rose cut diamonds, fitted with a safety chain, unmarked, weight 5.5g, inside width 5.5cm.

Condition Report

741. The wirework at the front is a bit distorted. There is a small piece of lead solder to the right of the lyre that may at one stage have taken a safety chain, which is now lacking. The silver setting is heavily tarnished. The diamonds have variation of cut with a few inclusions, some of which are surface reaching. The wire is likely to be gold. Suggested age 1880s.
