A Victorian gold, diamond and pale blue enamelled oval brooch, circa 1860, with a diamond set star shaped motif on a blue enamelled ground, the surround with applied bead and wirework decoration in the classical taste, the front with pendant tassel drops, unmarked, weight 18.5g, width 4.3cm.

Condition Report

755. The principal diamond has a gletz inclusion to one side. The diamonds generally draw colour to grey. There is variation of cut to the surrounding rose cut diamonds. Some of the rose cut diamonds have surface reaching inclusions. Some surface marks to the blue enamel. The central panel is a little loose. There is a small dent at the front at the hinge end. Small dent to border where the safety chain loop is fitted. Tassels are a little distorted in places to the terminals. All tassels are present. The locket frame to the back protrudes above the tassels, the hinge pin starting to come out at one end.

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
