779. The diamonds are rose cut. They slightly draw colour and some have surface reaching inclusions. The enamel scroll is a bit damaged to the word ♦Ducunt♦. The enamel to the ♦Ubique♦ scroll and crown is in good condition. Faint jeweller's code marks to the back. Suggested age circa 1940.
