LOT 542

A gold, emerald and diamond marquise shaped cluster ring, circa 1900, mounted with the principal rectangular cut emerald to the centre between split shoulders, unmarked, weight size 2.9g, ring size approx N1/2, with a case.

Estimate: £250 - £350

Condition Report

542. One of the smaller emeralds is badly chipped on the table facet. Some abrasion and nibbles to the emeralds in general. Few inclusions to emeralds, but in general these are minor.

Diamond are fairly white stone with one or two inclusions.

Very slight signs of wear to one or two claws. Some thinning to back of shank. Has been resized in the past.

Small repair to one side of one shoulder where it joins the mount, with potential other minor repairs in the past where the mount joins the shank, with silvery discolouration evident under 10x loupe.

Principal emerald approx 4mm x 3mm. slight variation of size to the other four emeralds.

Four principal diamonds very approx 0.03ct each.

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
