### Condition Report

412. The tankard has a misshapen foot and would require attention. Also a very slight misshaping to rim. Typical light wear to high points of decoration. Handle in good order with no repairs. Few small dent to body. Engraved initials to cartouche on side. Good clear hallmarks to base. Both candlesticks have dents, creases and wear.
