Condition Report

454. Generally good condition with no significant damage or repairs. The chain is broken and missing a section, and one of the side scrolls the chain is fixed to is bent down. Otherwise hinge is good, hinge to grille is good and both close down tightly. Gilt interior in good order and marks are clear. Typical light surface wear to highpoints on top and sides.
