A William IV silver vinaigrette of circular form with cast floral decorated rim, the engine turned hinged lid revealing a gilt hinged grille, pierced and engraved with foliate scrolls, with a similarly decorated suspension ring, Birmingham 1833 by Thomas Shaw, length including suspension ring 4.8cm, diameter 3cm, together with a silver neckchain on a boltring clasp, detailed 'Sterling', length 89.5cm, total weight 30.9g.

Condition Report

391. Generally good condition with no significant damage or repairs. Wear to engine turning on both sides. Both hinge and grille hinge in good order. Gilt interior is good and good clear hallmarks. Typical light surface wear to high points on sides, but nothing significant. Suspension loop and ring in similarly good order. Chain also in generally good condition.
