Condition Report

320. There are some small dents around the body, otherwise generally good condition with no other significant damage or repairs. Typical light surface wear and scratches. Hinge is good. Handle in good order, but ebonized insulators are chipped. Clear hallmarks to base and lid interior. Typical light wear to engraving, but still pretty good.
