Condition Report

171. Generally in good condition. Paint a little thin in small areas, possibly from previous cleans. UV examination is hindered slightly by the glass and the old varnish that flares up green. There may be some touches of overpainting beyond that, particularly around the girl's hat. The old varnish has started to discolour. The gilt frame appears to be the inner slip of something larger and there is some rubbing and minor dips to extremities. Unexamined out of the frame.
