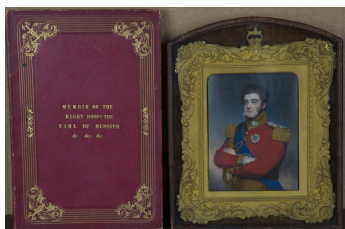

Condition Report

130. Ivory panel has warped considerably, but no splits or cracks yet. Otherwise in fairly good condition with no signs of rubbing or overpainting. Some minor blooming to the surface. Both the inner frame and the case have glass and both are quite dirty.

The inner frame seems to be in very good condition. The outer leather case is bumped, scuffed and generally a little rubbed.

The accompanying book has some age toning to the interior and the rear free endpaper is torn with loss. The binding has some scuffing to the extremities.
