A Rolex Oyster Explorer stainless steel cased gentleman's bracelet wristwatch, Ref. 1016, circa 1967, the signed jewelled 1570 caliber automatic movement detailed 'D954371', the signed black dial with luminous batons and Arabic hour markers and detailed 'Rolex Oyster Perpetual Explorer Superlative Chronometer Officially Certified, Swiss-T<25', Rolex crown to winding button, milled screw-off back, numbered between the lugs '1016' and '1590049', the signed case back interior numbered '1016', the tapered bracelet numbered '78360' with '580' endlinks and foldover clasp, case width 3.5cm, with guarantee booklet and trial certificate, numbered '1590049', spare link, green Rolex wallet, other related paperwork and a spare Rolex expandable bracelet, numbered '6636', with '80' endlinks and foldover clasp.
