### LOT 1185

A late 19th century French brass gorge cased carriage clock by Leroy & Fils, with eight day movement striking on a bell, the white enameled dial with black Roman hours and outer Arabic minutes, inscribed 'Leroy & Fils to the Queen Palais Royal 13-15 a Paris 296 Regent Street London', the backplate similarly inscribed 'Repassée par Leroy & Fils...' and numbered '7455' and '4291', the gorge case with bevelled glass panels and swing handle, height including handle 15.6cm, with a winding key.

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### Condition Report

1185. The case is very dirty and would certainly benefit from a clean, but otherwise appears to be in sound condition. All glass panels in good condition. Enamel dial in good clean condition. The movement does not wind and does not run.
