### LOT 1182

A late 19th century/early 20th century lacquered brass carriage clock with eight day movement striking hours and half hours and repeating on a gong, the circular enamel dial with black Arabic hour numerals within a matt gilt surround, the beaded corniche case with bevelled glass panels and swing handle, on bracket feet, height including handle 15.9cm, together with a leather travelling case and key.

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### Condition Report

1182. The clock is in generally good condition. The case has typical light surface scratches and wear. The front glass panel has a small chip to the top right corner, otherwise other glass panels are good. Dial in good clean condition. The movement winds and adjusts smoothly and is currently working with strike working on hours and half hours and on repeat. But please be aware we give no guarantees to working order or reliability of any clock or watch.

Outer travelling case is a bit worn and damaged and handle missing.

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
