A Second World War period Air Ministry cockpit clock by S. Smith & Sons (HA) Ltd London, the signed black dial detailed 'MK III A No 6576/36 Ref No 6A/676' above 'SR/43', the black enamelled case back stamped with crown above 'A.M', case diameter 9.5cm, later mounted as an oak mantel timepiece, height 14.2cm (two chips to glass), together with another Air Ministry cockpit clock by S. Smith & Sons, No. 1131/38, case diameter 9.5cm, later mounted in an oak mantel timepiece case, height 14.8cm.

Condition Report

1258. Neither clock is running.

The clock set in the arch case has typical wear to black enamelled surround and two chips to glass.

The rectangular cased example has some typical wear to black enamelling and crack to top right corner.
