A late 19th century brass mounted burr walnut cased mantel clock with eight day movement striking hours and quarters on two gongs, the backplate detailed 'Lenzkirch' and numbered '58597', the brass arched dial with matt centre and silvered chapter ring, the case with carved anthemion surmount above gilt brass finials and mounts and glazed front door, on a moulded rectangular base, height 39cm, with pendulum.

Estimate: £180 - £240

Condition Report

1215. The clock is in generally good condition with no significant damage or repairs. It is a little dusty and dirty so would certainly benefit from a tidy-up and polish. All metal mounts in place. Dial ok, but a little dirty. The case key for front door is missing, but it is currently open. Pendulum is present. Movement winds smoothly and runs, but please be aware we give no guarantees to working order or reliability of any clock or watch.
