### LOT 1321

A late 19th century French gilt metal and Sèvres style porcelain clock garniture, the mantel clock with eight day movement striking on a bell via an outside countwheel, the porcelain dial and panels within bleu céleste and gilt borders, the case with urn surmount and cast with scrolls, height 39.5cm, flanked by a pair of five light candelabra, height 41.5cm, together with a 20th century French gilt metal mantel clock, the case cast with cherubs, height 27cm (faults).

Estimate: £150 - £200

### Condition Report

1321. The clock garniture is a little dusty and dirty, but generally ok with typical wear and surface scratches. Clock in good order, with all porcelain in good condition. The candelabra metalwork appears to be ok, but both porcelain sections are damaged. No pendulum with Lot.

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
