A Victorian mahogany bracket clock with eight day triple fusee movement chiming quarters on eight bells and striking hours on a larger single bell, the silvered dial with subsidiary pendulum regulation dial to arch above strike/silent indicator, black Roman hour numerals and engraved foliate scrolls, inscribed 'Robert Rowlands London', the arched case with applied carved fruit moulding surmount above scrolls and flower festoon to front, on a plinth base, height 66cm, with pendulum.

Condition Report

1230. The case is in generally good condition with no significant damage or repairs. Bit dusty and dirty so would certainly benefit from a clean/polish. Both hinge doors close tightly, back door with small repair at top. The movement train winds smoothly and runs, but please be aware we give no guarantees to working order or reliability of any clock or watch. However, neither of the striking trains wind and the strike mechanism does not work.

Dial with minor scratches, wear and marks, but otherwise in good order.

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
