### LOT 518

A gold pendant, claw set with an oval opal, detailed '9ct', weight 1.6g, length 1.9cm, with a gilt metal neckchain, a 9ct gold ring, collet set with an oval opal, weight 3.6g, ring size approx N, and a pair of opal single stone earstuds, the butterflies detailed '9ct', with three cases.

### Condition Report

518. Pendant ♦ the opal has an attractive play of colour if a little subdued. Natural flaw at the back of the opal which is not visible at the front. Otherwise in good condition.

Ring ♦ the dominate play-of-colour is in shades of green and overall is a little subdued. Also evidence of dehydration crazing to back and front of the opal. A few surface scuff marks to the opal. The shank is in good condition. Hallmark ♦ Birmingham 1979. Would benefit from a clean.

Earstuds ♦ a little dirty around the opals where they meet the setting, so would benefit from a professional clean. The opals have an attractive play-of-colour, if a little subdued. One post is ever so slightly bent over. Tiniest of surface scratches to one opal.

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
