An Edwardian 18ct gold and diamond five stone ring, mounted with a row of graduated cushion cut diamonds between scrolled shoulders, London 1908, weight 2.8g, ring size approx N.

Condition Report

519. The diamonds although they are attractive white stones do have a few internal inclusions, some of which are surface reaching. One of the outer diamonds has a chip or large surface reaching inclusion. Hallmark clear. Otherwise in fairly good condition. Principal diamond weight approx 0.15ct. Outer edge diamonds weigh approx 0.07ct each. Diamonds 2 and 4 weigh approx 0.08ct each.

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
