### LOT 520

A 9ct gold, opal and ruby bar brooch, mounted with four pear shaped opals, London 1979, weight 3.1g, width 3.9cm, and a 9ct gold brooch, designed as a tied ribbon bow with a single opal drop, London 1988, weight 4.3g, width 2.7cm.

### Condition Report

520. Opal and ruby ♦ the ruby is of dark colour saturation and has a chip to the table facet edge. The opals have a few surface marks, one more so than the others, the play-of-colours are shades of green, violet and orange, but are a little subdued. There is some dehydration to one opal where it meets the ruby centre stone. Fitting in good working order.

Ribbon brooch ♦ the opal has a stronger play-of-colour compared to the other brooch. This opal drop is probably earlier than the bow brooch and is therefore in association. The roller of the clasp is very tight and does not roll over.

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
