### LOT 574

A silver mounted cornelian pendant fob seal, last quarter of the 19th century, designed as a seated dog, indistinct mark, weight 4.5g, length 2.8cm, and five unmounted intaglios, including a smoky quartz, engraved with an eagle crest, a cornelian, engraved with a classical bust, and an amethyst, monogram engraved.

### Condition Report

574. Seated dog seal ♦ cornelian is seal engraved ♦MD♦ and is in good condition. The dog surmount has slight surface wear, otherwise a little tarnished. Mark to soldered loop of the dog♦s collar probably French. Smoky quartz intaglio ♦ has traces of silver coloured paint, with slight wear and one or two tiny chips to the principal edge.

Cornelian with classical bust ♦ in good condition.

Amethyst intaglio ♦ is of medium to pale colour saturation. A chip to the principal facet edge. Otherwise in good condition. Monogrammed.

Bloodstone intaglio ♦ one corner cut down at the back, otherwise in good condition.

Oval intaglio ♦ probably a moulded black glass, note conchoidal chip to the side edge. The design looks to be moulded.
