An Edwardian gold, seed pearl and pale blue gem set pendant in a scroll pierced and beaded design, detailed '9ct Gold', weight 1.8g, length 5cm, with a gold neckchain, detailed '9ct', on a boltring clasp, detailed '375', weight 2g, length 45cm, and a silver, cultured pearl and garnet bead necklace on a boltring clasp, London 1982, weight 4.2g, length 44cm.

Condition Report

636. Pendant ♦ the seed pearls are of a silvery-grey colour. There are a few surface nicks to the table facet of the pale blue gem. Suspension connecting loop require closing up to make secure. The neckchain as a result of wear has been cutting into the sides of the pendant suspension. The pendant generally is in good condition. The centre of the bottom part is slightly distorted due to fragile nature of the design. The neckchain is in good condition, the boltring is a replacement but the neckchain itself is old.

Garnet and cultured pearl necklace ♦ some of the links of the chain are a bit distorted. Generally in good condition otherwise.

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
