### LOT 644

A ruby and diamond bar brooch, designed as a diamond set tied ribbon bow centred by a circular cut ruby with three rubies mounted to the knife bar, unmarked, width 4cm, with a case.

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### Condition Report

644. The rubies are of medium to dark colour saturation and generally have a few inclusions. These inclusions are surface reaching. The diamonds are a combination of old cut and rose cut diamonds, some of these diamonds draw colour. The diamonds generally have one or two inclusions and a few diamonds have surface reaching inclusions. There are old scratched code marks to the back of the bow. The piece is otherwise in generally good condition. The setting is silver. Suggested age ♦ late Victorian. Gross weight including safety chain 4.8g.

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
