Condition Report

1919. PLEASE NOTE, this report covers the 2016 coin only. If you require a report on the other coin please request this.

2016 half-sovereign - discolouration on the frosting at the top of the Queen's head. This could be a fingerprint although the box looks to have got damp at some point, so it could be a mould to the coin's surface. The mark appears to only be on the hair and not running into the field. The coin does not look to have been handled, but does have this issue.
