LOT 334

A late 19th century Continental silver gilt mounted cut glass scent bottle of faceted ovoid form, height 5.5cm (lacking stopper), a silver gilt mounted ruby faceted cut glass double ended scent bottle, length 13.5cm, and a silver gilt mounted clear faceted glass double ended scent bottle, each screw and hinged lid engraved with foliate scrolls, length 13.8cm.

Estimate: £100 - £150

Condition Report

334 - Red bottle - silver gilt has typical surface wear to both ends and the screw lid has a small dent to its centre. Screw lid otherwise in good order and screws down tightly. The other end has a spring hinged lid which pops open as it should and closes tightly. Exterior glass in good order. The inside rim of vinaigrette end has a small chip.

Clear glass bottle - generally good condition, typical light surface wear and scratches to silver gilt ends, but both ends open and close tightly. Glass in good order with only very minor nicks to edges.

Ovoid bottle - has no stopper but otherwise in good order, only typical minor wear.

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
