A Chinese blue and white porcelain jar and cover, Kangxi period, the baluster body painted with two female musicians surrounded by dancing boys, opposing two further maidens holding a scroll and accompanied by boys, the domed cover with two boys and rocks, underglaze blue double ring to base, height 35.5cm (repairs to neck, the cover with chip to rim and hairline), together with a carved hardwood circular stand.

Estimate: £400 - £600

Condition Report

1015. Cover with 11cm hairline crack running beneath the finial. It is visible to interior and less visible to exterior. The rim of the jar has been damaged and repaired with three broken out and re-glued sections, minor chipping along these breaks and 4cm vertical hairline to rim. All of this is visible in the images on our website. Small star crack visible to interior of body. Typical light surface scratches to glaze. Carved wood stand with splits to top and re-glued, otherwise ok.
