An Indian carved ivory dancing Shiva hair comb, 17th century, finely carved and pierced with the god dancing on a five-headed cobra forming a canopy, all framed by an arched flame mandala, length 15.4cm.

Condition Report

1120. Generally good condition with no significant damage or repairs. There is a chip to Shiva's right foot and the stem to his left is missing a small section and bud beside his left knee. Otherwise, the carving appears to be in good condition with only typical light surface wear commensurate with age. The comb is in good order with only minor chip to point of one.
