A Tibetan gilt copper rectangular panel, probably 17th century, decorated with a repoussé bird catcher, 30.4cm x 48.2cm (some faults).

Provenance: from the estate of a West Sussex collector.

Estimate: £100 - £150

Condition Report

1110 - Would appear to have been cut down from a larger panel as the design is not perfectly central. No gilding to the copper side edges, which also have some pin holes where it may have been mounted at some time. Some tears/splits to edges, but none that encroach too far into the panel. Wear to gilt and dirty. Some small dents and misshaping. Typical wear and scratches.
