A Tibetan brown patinated bronze stupa, 19th century, of bell shaped form, the ridged spire on a turned pedestal and stepped square base, height 17cm. Provenance: from the estate of a West Sussex collector.

Condition Report

1113 - Generally good condition but dirty and would certainly benefit from a clean. Spire with typical surface scratches and wear, but no significant damage or repairs. The base with two broken upper corners and some dents to other corner and edge. Plinth base with minor misshaping, wear and scratches. The Buddha within is damaged with breaks and losses. Weight 551.6g.
