Condition Report

1149 - Generally good condition but dirty so would certainly benefit from a clean. Typical light surface scratches and wear but no significant damage or repairs. Spire and base fit together tightly. Some minor misshaping to tiered finial on the spire and missing a few hanging flags. No marks. Weight 272.4g. Ebonized stand with scuffs, chips and wear.
