A Tibetan gilt metal and rock crystal stupa amulet, Qing dynasty, of bell form, the gilt metal circular base inset with coral, height 8.8cm, together with a wrapped-up sacred prayers seal with gilt bronze stupa, height 9.5cm, and three small stupa amulets, height 7.5cm and 5cm (some faults). Provenance: from the estate of a West Sussex collector.

Estimate: £150 - £250

Condition Report

1114. Rock crystal stupa - spire has been broken and re-glued. also very minor chips to edge of base. Gilt metal and coral inset base has some typical dents, wear and misshaping. Some minor breaks and losses to pierced gallery. Five coral insets are missing/damaged. Total weight 172.8g.

Rock crystal and gilt copper spire stupa - wear to gilt and surface scratches and wear to crystal. Stuck to wood base. Total weight 95.8g.

Silk parcel with gilt stupa seal - typical wear to stupa, missing one 'two ball stack' to its base. Silk is badly worn and discoloured in places. Total weight 134.3g.

Small crystal stupa - small chips to spire and chips around base. Also dirty and discoloured with wear and scuffs. Total weight 37.9g.

Metal spire stupa - dirty and worn with surface scratches. Weight 28.1g.
