Condition Report

1136. The bull is in generally good order with significant wear to gilt and red decoration with some areas of decoration completely worn. Right horn has been broken and repaired and right ear appears to have been broken and replaced with later ear. Numerous small chips and scuffs to alabaster, more significant chips around edges of base. Weight approx 13kg.
