Two Chinese brown patinated bronze healing horses, Qing dynasty, each modelled in a standing pose with mane detailing, lengths 17cm and 15.5cm. Provenance: from the estate of a West Sussex collector.

Condition Report

1123. Horse 1 - generally good condition with no significant damage or repairs. Good detail to mane and tail.

Hole to one side of neck and sealed hole to other side of neck. Typical light surface scratches and wear.

Horse 2 - it is a bit dirty and has a duller finish to the other horse. Generally good condition with sealed hole to back right hind leg and repaired/sealed section to hind left leg. Typical surface scratches and wear.
