A collection of Chinese export porcelain teaware, mostly Qianlong period, including famille rose teabowls and saucers, five famille rose coffee cups and a blue and white sparrow beak jug (some faults).

Estimate: £100 - £200

Condition Report

1219. Blue and white jug - chip and crack to base of handle, missing lid.

Blue and white custard cup - slight staining to glaze and missing cover.

Imari tea bowl - cracked, repaired and chipped.

Underglaze blue and famille rose saucer - cracked and chipped.

Blue and white Batavian ware saucer - good condition, no chips, cracks or repairs.

2 slightly larger famille rose bowls - one with hairline crack and rim chips, the other in good condition, typical wear.

5 famille rose saucers - 1 repaired, others with hairlines and rim chips.

1 lobed famille rose saucer - minor repaired rim chip, otherwise ok.

6 famille rose tea bowls - all with minor rim chips, minor rim repairs or hairline cracks to rims.

2 tea bowls with gilt grounds - both in generally good condition with no significant damage or repairs. Typical wear to gilt.

Larger famille rose coffee cup - replaced handle and rim chip.

Famille rose coffee cup - hairline crack to body and chips to rim.

Famille rose coffee cup - hairline cracks around base, minor nicks to rim and wear to gilt.

Famille rose coffee cup - two hairlines to rim and wear to gilt.

Famille rose coffee cup - hairline crack to base of handle, otherwise ok.

Please note, the majority of the famille rose and exportware has typical wear to enamels and gilt commensurate with age.
