### Condition Report

1111. in generally fair condition, but with some surface wear. Some fraying to silk and some light discolouration/staining, re-stitched sections of yellow ground to right hand side. Small tear to lower right section and a few other small holes worn through. Minor repairs to blue character. Later stitched on to a black ground. All this can be seen in the images on our website.
