A small group of Tibetan works of art, 19th century and later, including a white metal gau (prayer/amulet box) with applied coral and turquoise decoration, length 11.2cm, a ritual bell and vajra in a silk covered case, and an embossed circular dish, diameter 20.5cm. Provenance: from the estate of a West Sussex collector.

Estimate: £60 - £100

Condition Report

1133. The gau box is in poor condition with wear and losses to decoration, dents and splits to sides.

Relief plaster panel is chipped and worn.

The bell and vajra are in generally good order.

Small bronze bowl has a split to rim.

Cymbals are okay but worn.

Pottery vessel has chips to rims, otherwise okay.

Dish is worn but okay.
