A late 18th/early 19th century flintlock pistol by Goodwin, London, with octagonal sighted barrel, barrel length 8cm, engraved locks with shaped hammer and sliding safety, brass-mounted ramrod and carved chequered grip, together with a late 19th century powder flask.

## Condition Report

1840. Light evidence of rust to metal work. Light bruises and marks to wood work, one more prominent to grip area. Some light splits and loss to wood below barrel tip. Hammer does lock/fire, though clearly defective. Safety catch defective, file marks in this area suggest someone has tried to correct this.
