A late 18th century flintlock powder tester by Turner, Halifax, with graduated scale wheel with scrolling ratchet, the brass body with foliate decoration and chequered wooden grip.

Estimate: £60 - £100

Condition Report

1846. Would suggest it has been dis-assembled in recent times, the steel work looks to have been dipped/treated as a strange colour. Pan cover does not spring. Hammer half and full locks. Wheel action feels sticky. Some heavy fresh scuff marks to brass works behind trigger, some bruises to wooden grip, one deeper mark to top of handle.
