### LOT 661

A gold ring, collet set with the circular cut pink tourmaline within a pierced openwork surround, set with four seed pearls alternating with four rose cut diamonds in triangular shaped settings, unmarked, weight 2.5g (shank slightly distorted).

Estimate: £60 - £100

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### Condition Report

661. Some abrasion to the table facet edge of the tourmaline, with also a chip to the surface of a facet. The pearls have an attractive silvery lustre. One of the four rose cut diamonds has a substantial chip. The head of the ring has likely been repurposed as it is quite crudely attached to the shank, slightly crooked when viewed head on. The shank is oval in shape.

Due to the distorted shank, on a ring pole the size is approx J1/2, but it physically fits a finger M1/2 in size.

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
