Condition Report

348. Generally good condition, typical scuffs, wear and scratches. Silver is dirty, but otherwise in generally good order. Missing securing pin to top left corner so mount slightly loose in this area. Both sides with hallmarks displaying maker, Victoria head and date letter, but no London town mark or lion passant. Hinged clasp is good and closes tightly. Shield has engraved monogram. Crocodile skin is generally good, but has typical scuffs and wear, more pronounced at ends of spine. The page edges are a little dusty and pages have some staining, scuffs and damp spotting. Some of the pages with small tears.
