Condition Report

1828. Some areas of heavy rust to blade, in two patches. Overall wear to handle commensurate with use and age. Some marks and bruising to scabbard, point of scabbard with some heavy knocks/marks. Some breakdown to waist belt, leather drying out and cracking and splitting in places.
